

Research Participation IPN3442

As part of your bachelor-program, you have to participate in studies conducted by fellow psychology students and researchers. Every time you participate, you'll receive participation credits.

Why?

Research is very important for psychology, and many students (bachelor and master) and staff members depend on you!

YOU in turn:

- get acquainted with empirical research
- get acquainted with the research areas studied at FPN (and the researchers involved)
- get acquainted with different research methods and techniques

How many credits?

You will need to gather 20 credits in total (cohort 2016-2017).

For each half hour participation, ½ point is granted. The number of credits vary per study, depending on the total amount of time investment.

A maximum of 7 credits can be earned by online study participation.

Credits are registered in the Research Participation System (SONA).

Gather 15 credits in your **first year** and get 5 **CREDITS FOR FREE**.


How to gather credits?

- 3. Sign up for a study
- 4. Participate
- 5. Credits will be added to your account in SONA


Step 1: Go to www.maastricht-fpn.sona-systems.com

Important!

You may cancel a study before the **cancellation deadline**. In most cases this is 24h before the study is scheduled to occur, but it differs per study! Weekends are not included when determining if it is too late to cancel.

If you decide to cancel, you will receive an email confirmation of the cancellation, for your records.

For **unexcused no-shows**, the announced amount of credits will be subtracted from your total credits **(penalty credits)** which can result in a negative total.

Important!

You need to respect the maximum of 7 credits from online studies. Check this in your credits overview. If you exceed this number, the excess hours will not count towards your total.

How to get your ECTS?

When acquired the necessary participation credits, request your ECTS via the contact option of AskPsy
