

Admission Requirements second year courses and third -year courses. V. 2016-2017

In addition to the requirements of a binding study advice (BSA), admission requirements may apply for courses of the second and third year. **Please consult your Education and Examination Regulations.**

- Students who began their studies in 2012-2013 or earlier, no admission requirements apply for the courses Statistics II and III, the Research Practical and Psychodiagnostics .
- Students who began their studies in 2013-2014 or later, admission requirements apply for the courses **Statistics II and III, the Research Practical and Psychodiagnostics.**
 - To get admitted to Statistics II and III Statistics I should be completed successfully. To be admitted to Statistics II please take into account that on the record date of 15 March of the current academic year Statistics I should be completed successfully.
 - To get admitted to the Research Practical please take into account that on the record date of 15 March of the current academic year the following courses should be completed successfully:
 - Statistics I;
 - Methods and Techniques.
 - To get admitted to Psychodiagnostics Statistics I should be completed successfully.
- Students who wish to go to **abroad** for their **electives** first need to contact the International Relations Office (IRO).

Students who wish to go to another country for their electives should:

 - have passed all first-year courses;
 - have passed second-year courses of periods 1, 2 and 3;
 - have completed the experimental obligation.
